-Antigone is alive but all of her affinities and desires are w the dead/Polyneices -Antigone has a sort of ghostly quality so the character suits Noah theatre and its ghosts

-Creon: the state, the law is everything–even one's intimate, erotic desires should be subverted to the law (so Haemon should discard the "traitor" Antigone)

-Even God is a Theban according to Creon (therefore he will not accept a traitor into the afterlife so Polyneices shouldn't be buried)

-famous chorus passage praises human contrivance, progress, ability and is juxtaposed against Antigone being brought in, arrested, in chains–that is the tension (kind of like those who walk way from Omelas)

-question: is she a political actor? is she just involved in her own conscience? Or is it political activism to obey ones own conscience even in ones daily life?) 10/19 Girls-Yale Rep
